**SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY
PROGRAM IS SELECTED FOR A SITE VISIT BY
GENERAL MOTORS' SHANGHAI DIVISION**

Selden, NY - Suffolk County Community College's Automotive Technology Program was recently selected for a site visit by a delegation representing General Motors' Shanghai Division. The College was chosen as the host site for this visit from among 64 General Motors Automotive Service Educational Programs (ASEP) across the nation. Delegates from Shanghai Cadillac, Buick and Chevrolet along with instructors, administrators from education systems and employees of Raytheon Professional Services, LLC's training centers joined Suffolk County Community College's Automotive Technology professors, college administrators and students for a tour of the Automotive Technology Center and an overview of the Automotive Technology Program. The group also visited a General Motors dealership, where many graduates from SCCC's program find employment after completing their college internship.

Suffolk County Community College offers the General Motors ASEP program and multiple other A.A.S. degree programs in Automotive Technology. The Automotive Technology Program is housed in a 20,000 square-foot state-of-the-art facility, equipped with the latest technology including: nine fully functional shop bays; classrooms with the latest wireless technology enabling access to technical data for all makes and models of automobiles; Hunter Computerized Alignment Machines, Hunter Balancing Equipment; Mitchell On-Demand in all classes and a computerized engine analyzer and vehicle dynamometer that conforms with current New York State Inspection requirements.

The instruction, course of study, facilities and equipment in the program were evaluated by the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) and were found to meet the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) standards of quality for the training of automobile technicians in all areas.
