## SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FIRST ANNUAL ARTS FESTIVAL

Riverhead, NY – The Eastern Campus of Suffolk County Community College in Riverhead has announced the winners of the First Annual Arts Festival.

- Best in Show: Ericka Garcia (East Hampton High School) Violence Will Not Silence Us (watercolor, coffee, ink on paper)
- Best Video/Animation: Thomas Van Scoyoc (East Hampton High School) Hesterna (DVD)
- Best Photography: Casey Leach (Bellport High School) Woman (photo)
- Best Drawing/Painting: Daniel Kim (Commack High School) X-Ray Vision (Charcoal Pencil)
- Best Design: Esteban Aguilar (East Hampton High School) Graphic Maze (Digital Print)
- Best 3D Design: Victor Rodriquez (Commack High School) Peacock (cardboard and wood)
- Best Ceramics: Olivia Drutjons (Amityville High School) *Under the Same Sky* (ceramics)

The College received 99 pieces of artwork from 89 student artists representing several Long Island high schools – East Hampton High School, Bellport High School, Longwood High School, Eastport South Manor High School, Riverhead High School, Mattituck High School, Amityville High School, William Floyd High School, Commack High School, Center Moriches High School, Connetquot High School, and Hampton Bays High School, as well as Eastern Suffolk BOCES. Artwork was submitted in a wide variety of media, including drawing, painting, photography, ceramics, sculpture, graphic design, fabric design, video, animation and mixed media. The theme this year was *Design for the Times*. To enhance atmosphere, current Suffolk County Community College students sang a mix of Beatles songs a cappella during the festival. Food was provided by Sunshine Café.

The competition was judged by members of the College's faculty, including Professor Laurette Lizak, Professor Laurie Buckley, Professor Richard Mizdal and Professor Mark Moritz.

Commenting on the event, Dawn DiPeri, presenter, organizer and Professor of Graphic Design at Suffolk County Community College, stated, "I want students to know that what they are

doing is in fact valuable. It is clear that these emerging artists will be the future creative innovators of tomorrow."
