Selden, NY – Suffolk County Community College student, Dana Mondello, a resident of East Setauket, was recently recognized by the New York State Cooperative and Experiential Education Association (NYSCEEA) as a Student of the Year.

This annual award recognizes outstanding achievement in, and contribution to, experiential education. Awards are given to one student from a two-year college and one student from a four-year college or university.

Ms. Mondello is a Criminal Justice major on the Ammerman Campus of Suffolk County Community College and expects to graduate at the conclusion of the current fall semester. Her goal is to become a Suffolk County Police Officer. While attending Suffolk, she participated in Suffolk County Community College's Cooperative Education and Internship Program.
