SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE CLAIMS SECOND PLACE AMONG TWO-YEAR COLLEGES FOR ATHLETIC EXCELLENCE

Selden, NY – Suffolk County Community College has claimed second place among national two-year colleges in the National Alliance of Two-Year College Athletic Administrators (NATYCAA) Directors' Cup, an award that is presented annually by the National Association of Collegiate Athletic Directors of America (NACDA) and NATYCAA to the top intercollegiate two-year athletic programs in the nation.

The Cup recognizes institutions that excel at a national level in both men's and women's team athletics. Started in 1993-1994, only Division I programs were awarded this honor by NACDA and USA Today. It was expanded in 1995-1996 to include Division II, III and the NAIA and, in 2011-2012, expanded to include Junior and Community Colleges.

Each institution is awarded points in a pre-determined number of sports for men and women. The overall champion is the institution that records the highest number of points in their division's Directors' Cup standings.

Kevin Foley, Interim Director of Athletics at Suffolk County Community College, accepted the cup on behalf of the College at the Directors' Cup Awards Luncheon, which was held as part of the NACDA Annual Convention in Orlando, Florida in June.

Coach Foley said, "The Suffolk athletic program is honored to win this prestigious national award. It is an indication of the College's, President McKay's and the athletic department's commitment to excellence. This award is a tribute to the dedication of our coaches and the commitment of our student athletes."
