



**Feminist Shelby Knox, Subject of a Sundance Award Winning Film, Speaks at Suffolk County Community College March 26, Part of Eastern Campus Feminist Film Series and Women's History Month.**

Shelby Knox, the subject of a 2005 documentary and Sundance award-winning film profiling her as a teenager who joins a campaign for comprehensive sex education in the high schools of Lubbock, Texas and struggles to reconcile her newfound political beliefs with her conservative religious views will speak at Suffolk County Community College's Eastern Campus on March 26.

Knox will appear as a featured speaker at The Suffolk County Community College Eastern Campus Feminist Film Series that began in February and continues through the spring 2014 semester. Three of the series' eight films will be screened in March during Women's History Month.
