Energy Efficiency Saves Suffolk Community College, Taxpayers and Environment.



The Long Island Power Authority (LIPA), now PSE&G Long Island, notified Suffolk County Community College that it will be receiving a rebate check for \$8,000 as a result of high-efficiency L.E.D. lighting it installed in the Peconic Building at the College's Eastern Campus in Riverhead. "This most recent savings brings the College's total income from rebates, energy efficiency projects and grants to \$1,667,122," said College President Dr. Shaun L. McKay. McKay said that since 2000, the College has engaged in nearly 50 projects including energy efficiency and energy curtailment that includes installing high efficiency heating and air conditioning, solar panels and L.E.D. lighting across the institution's three campuses.
