## SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE PRESENTS *THE COSMIC EARTH BULL SERIES* BY SHEILA ISHAM THROUGH APRIL 1, 2011 ON THE EASTERN CAMPUS

Riverhead, NY - The Lyceum Gallery located on the Eastern Campus of Suffolk County Community College in Riverhead will present *The Cosmic Earth Bull Series*, an exhibit of paintings by Sheila Isham through April 1, 2011. Ms. Isham's colorful exhibit will also be the inaugural exhibit at the newly constructed Lyceum Gallery located in the new Montaukett Learning Resource Center at the College's Riverhead Campus.

Southampton artist, Sheila Isham, creates monumental oil paintings of animal herds migrating through a colorful, dreamlike space. Isham's animals appear contemplative and knowing, aware that they are carriers of ancient instincts, "seers" or barometers of the state of our natural environment. Isham includes primal figures, partners and guardians of the wild beasts, aware of their interconnectedness. They are the unspoiled, "noble savages," that speak for the animals and remind us of our role as custodian to all of life, great and small.

Isham's resume includes a long list of accolades. She has been painting for over fifty years and has exhibited her work in museums and galleries around the world. Her work is in a number of museum collections including The Hirshhorn Museum in Washington, D.C. and The Museum of Modern Art in New York. Isham was given a career retrospective at the Russian State Museum in St. Petersburg in 2004 that included a comprehensive exhibition catalogue titled *Sheila Isham* by Alexander Kiblitsky. 
