Selden, NY – Suffolk County Community College has been recognized with a Gold Paragon Award for the best community college print ad in North America by the National Council for Marketing and Public Relations (NCMPR).

NCMPR is an affiliate of the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) and holds the Paragon Awards annually to recognize outstanding achievement in communications at community colleges and is the only national competition of its kind that exclusively honors excellence among marketing and PR professionals at two-year colleges.
