SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S CULINARY ARTS PROGRAM HONORS COMMUNITY LEADERS' SUPPORT FOR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Riverhead, NY – On Friday evening, May 3, 2013, the Suffolk Community College Culinary Arts Program hosted a gala celebrating Long Island's forty years of wine production and raised more than \$9,000 for student scholarships supporting culinary arts education.

In a room filled to capacity, the College recognized Long Island Wine Council Board President Ron Goerler, Jr. and Executive Director Steven Bate for their dedication to the local wine industry and culinary community. Mr. Goerler was also presented with a Riverhead Town Resolution by Supervisor Sean Walter and a Suffolk County Legislature Proclamation from Legislator Al Krupski.

The menu, which contained a choice of ten entrees, plus a salad and dessert, was prepared and served by more than fifty Suffolk County Community College culinary students and a dozen faculty members. Wine was donated by ten local wineries. Richard Olsen-Harbich, wine maker for Bedell Cellars Winery and Kareen Massoud, wine maker for Paumanok Vineyards, gave brief presentations discussing the growth of the wine industry over the past forty years. Over fifty local businesses donated prizes for the silent and live auctions.
