FELIPE A. ESPITIA CETINA SWORN IN AS SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S STUDENT TRUSTEE FOR THE 2013-2014 ACADEMIC YEAR

Selden, NY – Suffolk County Community College recently conducted a swearing-in ceremony to install Felipe A. Espitia Cetina as the College's Student Trustee for the 2013-2014 academic year. The 19 year-old attends the Michael J. Grant Campus in Brentwood. Suffolk County Community College is governed by a 10-member Board of Trustees that sets policy for the College.
