Selden, NY - On Sunday, November 8, 2009 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., Suffolk County Community College will host an Open House for prospective students at the following locations on its three campuses:

Faculty and administrators will be on hand to offer detailed information regarding the more than 65 programs of study available at Suffolk County Community College. Financial aid representatives will discuss the grants and loans process as well as the many academic scholarships available at SCCC. Members of the admissions staff will also be available to guide students and parents through the admissions process and answer questions about attending SCCC.
