**SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE PRESENTS  
REMEMBERING 9/11 FROM AUGUST 29 – SEPTEMBER 28, 2011  
ON THE EASTERN CAMPUS**

Riverhead, NY - The Lyceum Gallery located in the Montaukett Learning Resource Center on the Eastern Campus of Suffolk County Community College in Riverhead, will present *Remembering 9/11*, a memorial exhibit marking the ten years since the September 11<sup>th</sup> attacks. The exhibit will run from August 29 through September 28, 2011.

*Remembering 9/11* is a group show by artists who work in a variety of media, including painting, photography, printmaking, digital media, and assemblage. Photographer Seymour Levy, a resident of Woodmere, who was an eyewitness to the attack on the World Trade Center, will be showing six of his photographs. Mr. Levy's photographs were exhibited at the Smithsonian Institute, and one will be permanently displayed at Ground Zero.

Gina Gilmore, a resident of New Suffolk, will be showing a series of linoleum prints of figures embracing. These prints will be sewn into a large quilt meant to comfort those grieving the loss of a loved one. Joan Rogers, a resident of Aquebogue, will show her assemblage works honoring the memory of the soldiers lost in the conflicts that followed the 9/11 attack. Roz Dimon, a resident of Shelter Island and Manhattan, will exhibit a 48" light box illuminating digital images accompanied by a story detailing her reflections of the events of 9/11.

Shelter Island's Janet Culbertson, Wading River's Anna Jurinich, Sag Harbor's Elizabeth Malunowicz, Quogue's Steve Alpert, and Southampton's Dennis Snyder will all present symbolic images of the effects of the conflicts precipitated by the 9/11 attacks.

Directions to the Eastern Campus: Take the Long Island Expressway to exit 70. Take County Road 111 four miles to County Road 51. Turn left toward Riverhead and go north on County Road 51. After 3.5 miles, turn right onto Speonk-Riverhead Road to the campus entrance on the right.
