## SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE CULINARY ARTS PROGRAM ANNOUNCES FUNDRAISER

Riverhead, NY - Suffolk County Community College's Culinary Arts program will host its third annual fundraiser, a Steakhouse Gala, on Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:45 p.m. at the College's Culinary Arts and Hospitality Center located at 20 East Main Street in Riverhead.

The cost to attend this event is \$75.00 per person and reservations are required. Admission includes an evening of great food, wine and entertainment. The event will also feature silent and Chinese auctions with prizes including a sky diving experience, a weekend getaway in Connecticut, a weekend visit to a bed and breakfast on the East End and a Keurig coffee machine with one-month supply of coffee.

The evening's menu begins with a raw bar including a shellfish sampler of shrimp cocktail, clams on the half shell and oysters on the half shell. This is followed by a salad of crisp local lettuce, fresh tomato, bacon crumbles and bleu cheese dressing.

The second course includes steakhouse carving stations of charcoal-grilled porterhouse steak, roast prime rib of beef au jus and grilled beef tenderloin in red wine sauce. These stations are accompanied by steakhouse side dishes of roasted Portobello mushrooms, creamed spinach and dauphinoise potatoes. A grand fish station will offer grilled salmon and crème fresh dill sauce and a pasta station will serve saffron orzo with spring peas and asparagus. Dinner concludes with a chef's selection of dessert and coffee.
