Dear Chair Murray and Members of the Board of Directors,

I wanted to apologize for being on the call late. I messed up and thought the call was at 4 PM. By the time, I got on the call, the meeting had shifted back to the Board of Trustees. I am very sorry. As directed, I have written out my report below.

The attached report covers September 1, 2019 to April 30, 2020. All cost centers in the Association are trending a in a positive fashion except for the Peconic Café. The Peconic Café is running a deficit in the amount of \$50,243.00. We have a deficit because we are still employing our Café workers despite our not being able to generate any income in the Café with the closure of the College.

The Association continues to run a lot of virtual events as reported by Student Trustee Gambina with a great amount of student participation. However, it is not as much as we would in person. Therefore, we are currently working on a plan to credit students returning in the summer/fall or refund to students not returning a portion of the student activity fee.

Thanks to the Director of the Association Barbara Hurst, the Association applied and received \$386,342 as part of the Paycheck Protection Program. This will allow the Association to keep all employees on the payroll for the next two months.

The Association is preparing for a 7% decline in the Student Activity fees for fiscal year 2020-21. The Association budget presentation will take place at the June meeting.

I want to thank Student Trustee Gambina for her assistance during the Covid-19 crisis and to congratulate her on her reelection as the Student Trustee for the 2020-21 academic year.
