<p>Federal Stafford Loan</p> <p>Available for all summer sessions (6/1/09 – 8/5/09)</p> <p>IMPORTANT: All forms must be on file <u>by April 15, 2009</u> to ensure your loan is approved prior to your payment due date</p>	<p><i>Summer Aid Request Form</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>» 2008-09 FAFSA</p> <p><i>First-time borrowers <u>must</u> complete entrance loan counseling at www.mappingyourfuture.org</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must enroll for a minimum 6 credits (all sessions combined) • Must have remaining loan eligibility (fall/spring and summer combined may not exceed annual loan limits) • Annual loan limits for 2008-09, including summer term: <i>1st year (< 32 cr.): \$5500</i> <i>2nd year (32+ cr.): \$6500</i> Independent students: up to \$4000 additional Unsubsidized Loan.
<p>Federal Pell Grant</p>	<p><i>Summer Aid Request Form</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>» 2008-09 FAFSA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Available only if student enrolled at SCCC during fall 2008 or spring 2009 in a degree program. • Must have remaining eligibility, i.e., maximum available grant not paid in fall 2008/spring 2009 semesters at SCCC or any other college.
<p>Federal Work-Study (FWS)</p>	<p><i>Summer Aid Request Form</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>» 2009-10 FAFSA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be registered for fall 2009 courses • Must demonstrate financial need
<p>TAP (NYS Grant)</p>	<p>» 2009-10 FAFSA</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p><i>Express TAP Application (apply when filing FAFSA)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For full- or part-time study (minimum 6 credits) • NOT recommended if student plans to attend a four-year school or if unable to complete degree at SCCC within two years. <u><i>Discuss with Financial Aid before applying.</i></u>

PAYMENT DEADLINES / DEFERMENT PROCEDURES:

To avoid de-scheduling, payment for summer courses is due on the following dates:

1 st Five week session / Eight week session	May 18 th
2 nd Five week session	June 22 nd

If financial aid is approved prior to above dates, you may request a deferral of payment from the Financial Aid Office. **IMPORTANT: We recommend that you apply for the above financial aid programs at least four weeks prior to your payment due date.**
