Selden, NY - Suffolk County Community College's Gerald Reminick, Professor Emeritus of Library Services, recently published *Return to Our Pond, Another Year in the Life of St. John's Pond* by Glencannon Maritime Press.

In 2004, Professor Reminick's *Our Pond* described the charm, beauty and fascination of St. John's Pond in a year-long diary of thoughts, photographs and poems. Two years later, the author now describes, with care and feeling, the changes that have occurred at St. John's Pond in this touchstone of peace and serenity that is best read day by day, allowing the reader to reflect on the joy of life and the beauty of nature.

A portion of the profits from the sale of *Return to Our Pond* will be donated to the St. John's Summer Day Camp and the Volunteer Fund of the Long Island Chapter of the Nature Conservancy.

In addition to his work on *Our Pond*, Professor Reminick has also published eight books on the topic of the U.S. Merchant Marine and Navy Armed Guard. He is currently working on a series of children's books.
