I Have A Dream Chronicles The Life and Times of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

A dramatization of the life and times of one of our nation's most influential and charismatic civil rights leaders, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., will be presented on the Suffolk County Community College Michael J. Grant Campus in Brentwood on Wednesday, February 26, 2014 at 11 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Bruce Craig Miller's *I Have a Dream* brings to the stage a chronicle of Dr. King's life as he – inspired by the arrest of Rosa Parks -- becomes the prime mover behind the Montgomery, Alabama bus boycott and puts his philosophy of non-violent protest to work. King gains national recognition and becomes the dominant force in the Civil Rights movement during its decade of greatest achievement.

King's story, his struggle and his dream to "... lift our nation from the quicksand of racial injustice to the solid rock of brotherhood" will inspire.
