Selden, NY - The Suffolk County Police Department has been selected as Employer of the Year by the New York State Cooperative Experiential Education Association (NYSCEEA) for its internship program with Suffolk County Community College.

Police Officer Victoria Seeger, Suffolk County Police Department's Internship Program Director, recently received a plaque of recognition after a nomination from Debra Klein, Suffolk County Community College's Internship Coordinator. The annual award by NYSCEEA recognizes outstanding contributions and accomplishments in the field of cooperative and/or experiential education and is given to employers in both the profit and not-for-profit sector.
