SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENT RANKS IN TOP 20 AT NATIONAL BILLIARDS COMPETITION HOSTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN

Selden, NY - Suffolk County Community College student, Brittany Mandell of Riverhead, represented the College at the Association of College Unions International (ACUI) National Billiards Competition at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor on July 16 -17, 2010. Ms. Mandell, the only community college student in the Women's Division, was matched against some of the finest collegiate billiards players in the country as she participated in a two day, double elimination tournament. Ms. Mandell, finished the tournament and ranked in the top 20 of all women nationwide.

In February of 2010, Ms. Mandell and two other students from the Billiards Club on the Eastern Campus of Suffolk County Community College attended the Region 3 Qualifying Tournament in Newark, New Jersey. Ms. Mandell won four out of six matches to earn an invitation to participate in the National Tournament.

SCCC's Coordinator of Health, Wellness, Recreation, and Orientation, Denny Teason, travelled and coached Ms. Mandell throughout both competitions. "Brittany is a fierce competitor and it showed as she navigated through the Regional and National Tournaments. She represented SCCC well and established a strong presence for the College among the collegiate powerhouses across the country that participate in this sport." Mr. Teason noted.

Ms. Mandell is a Liberal Arts Major who expects to graduate from SCCC after the fall 2010 semester. She plans to transfer to a four-year institution to earn a bachelor's degree in Anthropology.
