Selden, NY- The Maurice N. Flecker Memorial Gallery, on the Ammerman Campus of Suffolk County Community College in Selden, is pleased to present an exhibition of recent prints published by Forth Estate Editions.

Forth Estate was founded in 2005 by Luther Davis and Glen Baldridge in the interest of producing editioned works by emerging artists using both traditional and technologically innovative approaches to printmaking. Techniques represented in the show include silkscreen, intaglio, lithography, chine collé, and digital printing.

Luther Davis is a master printer who has been printing fine art editions in New York since 1997. Glen Baldridge is an artist and printmaker living and working in Brooklyn, NY.

Forth Estate prints are in the collections of the New York Public Library, Museum of Modern Art, Whitney Museum of American Art, Newark Public Library, the Spencer Museum of Art, the RISD Museum, and the Jundt Art Museum.

Gallery hours are Monday through Thursday from 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. and Friday from 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
