SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE ANNOUNCES FALL 2012 GET THERE FROM HERE SCHOLARS

Selden, NY – Suffolk County Community College is please to announce the students who have been selected to receive *Get There From Here* scholarships to attend Suffolk County Community College beginning with the fall 2012 semester.

The goal of the *Get There From Here* scholarship program is to promote academic excellence and provide an opportunity for outstanding members of Suffolk County's diverse populations to attain their educational goals. This important initiative is made possible through a multi-million gift made to the Suffolk Community College Foundation in 2008.

This year, a total of 33 new *Get There From Here* scholarships were awarded. These scholars will join the 16 continuing recipients who were selected to receive awards in past years. The maximum annual award is \$5,000 per student and the scholarship can be renewed for a maximum of five semesters as long as all eligibility requirements continue to be met. Scholars are able to use the funds to cover tuition, fees, books and supplies.

Students chosen to receive the scholarship must commit to remaining continuously enrolled at the College and must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Scholars must also volunteer for 10 hours of community service per semester at an approved agency/non-profit organization, attend cultural events throughout the year and participate in a service learning project, student ambassador leadership program, or an internship.
