SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE PRESENTS CHARACTER: AN EAST END ARTS COUNCIL MEMBERS' EXHIBIT JANUARY 27 THROUGH FEBRUARY 24, 2012

Riverhead, NY – In conjunction with the East End Arts Council (EEAC), The Lyceum Gallery, located in the Montaukett Learning Resource Center on the Eastern Campus of Suffolk County Community College in Riverhead, will present *Character: An East End Arts Council Members' Exhibit*, opening on January 27 and running through February 24, 2012. This will be a non-juried exhibit.

Works to be displayed will be "miniatures," no larger than 12 inches in any direction. The theme that the EEAC has chosen is "Character." Jane Kirkwood, EEAC Gallery Director explains, "Van Gogh taught us that even a chair can have character. The subject of entries should be anyone or anything with a distinct character."

When the exhibit opens on Friday, January 27th, there will be a reception and performance art display from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Light refreshments will be served. This event is free and open to the public. During this time, performance artists will circulate through the exhibit. Some examples of the performance art include: dance, mime, magic, a cappella song, acting, juggling, yo-yo tricks, contortionists, tai chi, and brief comedy.
