**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors hereby amend the Certificate of Incorporation of the Suffolk Community College Association, Inc. by adding the following purposes to the "SECOND" paragraph:

- "5. To establish and operate one or more food service facilities.
- 6. To provide for the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, all for the purposes set forth in subparagraphs (1) and (2) above."

**RESOLVED,** that the President of the Board execute and file a Certificate of Amendment encompassing the foregoing with the Secretary of State.

# RESOLUTION NO. 2007.A6 CREATING NEW POSITIONS AND APPROVING SALARY SCHEDULES AND STIPENDS FOR 2007-2008

WHEREAS, the College Association Advisory Committee, the Children's Learning Centers Advisory Committee, and the appropriate administrators have recommended that there be a step plus 3% cost of living increase in 2007-2008 in the salary schedules for full-time Association employees, and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committees and administrators have also recommended a 3% cost of living increase in 2007-2008 for the hourly salaries as indicated for part-time Association employees, and

WHEREAS, as the head coach for volleyball, soccer, tennis and softball perform year round duties including recruitment and practice, it is necessary to establish off-season coach stipends in the Athletic Salary Schedule to compensate for these duties, and

WHEREAS, First and Second Assistant Coach positions have been eliminated and replaced with four Assistant Coach positions with salary ranging from 20%-60% of the Head Coach salary, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a Wellness and Recreational Assistant position in the Athletic Salary Schedule for the Eastern Campus to implement wellness-related and recreational opportunities, programs, and events, and

WHEREAS, the College Dean of Students has approved these recommendations, and the President concurs, be it therefore

**RESOLVED**, that the 2007-2008 salary schedules for employees of the Children's Learning Centers, Association Business Office, and Dining Services (Attachments A-XXIII, A-XXIV and A-XXV respectively) are hereby approved, and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the 2007-2008 Association salary schedule for Athletics, including the Off-Season Coach salaries and the Wellness and Recreational Assistant salary (Attachment A-XXVI) is hereby approved, and be it further



**RESOLVED,** that the 2007-2008 Association salary schedules in Theatre/Performing Arts and Student Life (Attachments A-XXVII and A-XXVIII respectively) are hereby approved, and be it further
