Chair Murray called for a motion to adjourn the Board of Trustees meeting and convene the Board of Directors meeting at 9:04 a.m. Trustee Pagdanganan so moved, Trustee deLeon-Lopresti seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

Chair Murray called for a motion to approve the Association minutes of the December 8, 2022 meeting. Trustee Pagdanganan so moved, Trustee O'Connor seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.

Chair Murray introduced Dr. Patricia Munsch, Vice President for Student Affairs, to present the Association financial report. Dr. Munsch reported the financial report was as of December 31, 2022. The Association continues to work within the parameters of its current budget, and most areas are managing their budgets appropriately. There is a

deficit for both childcare centers. Those deficits are based on awaiting SUNY operating grants that are due to come into the Association shortly. Each campus childcare center will receive approximately \$100,000 in funding to support both centers. In addition, the Grant Campus Kids Cottage will receive an additional grant based on the student demographics related to the center, and that additional grant will further subsidize student childcare fees at the Grant Campus.

The Association has a resolution for approval to hire the manager of dining services on the Eastern Campus, Mr. Aaron Jacino. He will be running the day-to-day operations of the Peconic Cafe, and this will allow the College to provide food service to the students on the Eastern Campus. Mr. Jacino comes with an extensive work history, including serving as catering and dining managers at local restaurants, working in college environments, along with spending time in Florida working in high-end restaurants. The position is being offered at Step 5, but it is prorated to a 42-week salary. This is because the Peconic Cafe will be open only during the spring and fall semesters; it will not be open when classes are not in session, and it will not be open during winter or summer sessions. This is to ensure fiscal responsibility on behalf of the Association, as is does not have significant income coming in during those times for food service in the cafe.
