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ARTICULATION AGREEMENT ADDENDUM

Molloy College Social Work (BSW) Program and Suffolk County Community College Human Services Program (AS)

Molloy College Department of Social Work and Suffolk County Community College Human Services Program agree to articulate as described below in order to facilitate and encourage the entrance of graduates of the Human Services Program into BSW curriculum at Molloy College.

Students graduating from the Human Services Program at Suffolk County Community College (SCCC) with an Associate in Science degree with a 2.7 GPA are eligible for admission to the Baccalaureate Social Work Program at Molloy College.

In addition to the successful completion of SCCC Human Services Program, admission to Molloy College Social Work Program requires acceptance into Molloy College, a personal interview by the Baccalaureate Director of the Department of Social Work, a favorable recommendation from an SCCC faculty member, and submission of a personal essay.

Acceptance of transfer credits is as specified in the Molloy College catalog current at the student's date of entry.

Provided students in the Human Services Program follow the recommendations for social work candidacy in the SCCC College catalog, 64 credits will be accepted by Molloy College toward the Bachelor's Degree in Social Work.

A \$2,000 transfer grant is awarded to full-time SCCC students who have a minimum 2.7 GPA and enroll in a minimum of 12 credits per semester at Molloy College. Transfer scholarships ranging from \$1,500 to \$5,000 are available to students who are enrolled full-time at SCCC for the two semesters prior to transfer, graduate from SCCC with a 3.0 GPA or higher, and enroll in a minimum of 12 credits per semester at Molloy College. Phi Theta Kappa members receive a \$1,000 per year scholarship.




