SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAM**

Stony Brook University School of Social Welfare, Undergraduate Social Work Program and Suffolk County Community College, Human Services Program, advance a memorandum of understanding as described below in order to facilitate and encourage the entrance of graduates of the Human Services Program into the Bachelor of Science with a major in Social Work (BSW) Program at Stony Brook University.

Students from Suffolk County Community College may apply for admission to the CSWE accredited Bachelor of Science with a major in Social Work (BSW) Program at Stony Brook University School of Social Welfare. The criterion for the acceptance of transfer credits and the meeting of prerequisites is specified in the School of Social Welfare catalogue in effect at the time of the student's application to the BSW program.

Students in the Human Services Program who successfully complete the recommended sequence of courses at Suffolk County Community College with a minimum 2.5 GPA and are awarded an Associate in Science degree will have all credits accepted by the School of Social Welfare toward the BSW degree.

Both parties agree to inform the other of changes in curricula or program in order that the other institution may consider changes in their offerings.


